In mid-September the removal of the current playground will commence and installation of the new playground will occur on **Thursday September 30**th, **Friday October 1**st and **Saturday October 2**nd.

Installation Details: We Need Your Help!

We need over **100 adult volunteers** to sign up for shift crew leaders and shift workers to help install the new play area. We also require one food service leader and three food service workers for each shift.

There will be 4-hour shifts available:

- Thursday, September 30th from 4:00 pm until 8:00 pm
- Friday, October 1st from 8:00 am 12:00 pm, 12:00 4:00 pm and 4:00 pm - 8:00 pm
- Saturday, October 2nd from 8:00 am until 12:00 pm and 12:00 pm until 4:00 pm.

Once you have signed up, you will be sent a detailed letter describing what to expect and what tools to bring. Unfortunately, children cannot help with the installation because of the heavy equipment and dangers on-site. The school has made arrangements to keep the children from the playground area during school hours on Thursday and Friday.

We are in need of celebration planners; volunteer coordinators and many other jobs to successfully complete this installation. In short, we still need many hands to lighten the load.
