

Awards at Bishop Pinkham

Bishop Pinkham wants to recognize the effort and excellence of its students. To that effect, numerous awards have been created. Our students' success and achievement are celebrated through our Honour Roll, grade assemblies throughout the year and our awards ceremonies at the end of the June.

Here are the various awards we present to deserving BP students:

Subject Awards

Certificates are presented to the top students in each class (core subjects, options and Physical Education included). These certificates are awarded based on marks before the final exams.

Honour Roll Awards

Certificates are presented to all students who have achieved first class honours on all four reporting periods.

Gauss Math Contest Award

A certificate is awarded to all participants.

Pascal Math Contest Award

A certificate and a medal are awarded to the student with the top mark.

Citizenship Awards

A certificate is awarded to students who have received a minimum of nominations by teachers and peers. Criteria: positive leadership, empathy and ethics. Plaques are presented to students in each grade who have received the most nominations and their names are engraved on a trophy that remains at Bishop Pinkham.

Most Improved Student Awards

Certificates are presented to students who have demonstrated significant improvement in various areas: academic performance,

attendance, cooperation, organizational skills, completion of homework, and other criteria as established by the grade communities. A plaque is presented to the top most improved student and the name of the recipient is engraved on a trophy that remains in the school.

Athletic Awards

Plaques are presented to the top female and the top male athletes in each grade and their names are engraved on a trophy that remains at Bishop Pinkham.

Foods Award

A plaque is presented to the top grade 9 student who has demonstrated the highest level of skills and knowledge as well as a positive attitude. The name of the recipient is also engraved on a trophy that remains in the school.

Construction and Design Award

A plaque is presented to the top grade 9 student who has demonstrated the highest level of craftsmanship, design, skills and safety. The name of the recipient is also engraved on a trophy that remains in the school.

Art Award

A plaque is presented to the top grade 9 student who has demonstrated outstanding achievement. The name of the recipient is also engraved on a trophy that remains in the school.

J.S. Birne Sportsmanship Award

A plaque is presented to the top grade 9 student who has demonstrated the highest level of sportsmanship. The name of the recipient is also engraved on a trophy that remains in the school.

Drama Award

A plaque is presented to the top grade 9 student who has demonstrated the highest level of achievement. The name of the recipient is also engraved on a trophy that remains in the school.

Outdoor Education Award

A plaque is presented to the top grade 8 and to grade 9 students who have demonstrated the highest level of outdoor skills and leadership. The names of the recipients are also engraved on a trophy that remains in the school.

Top Scholastic Awards

A plaque is presented to the top grade 7, 8, and 9 students in each program (Late French Immersion, Continuing French Immersion and English) based on highest average in all subjects. The names of the recipients are engraved on a trophy that remains in the school.
