Fast Track Registration

Students are expected to pre-register prior to the first day of school. Please arrive the school on either August 27 or August 28 between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Pre-registration includes : taking yearbook photo/ school I.D. card photo and picking up timetables.

Fees & Waivers

Changes to My CBE Account

Over the summer, changes will be made to My CBE Account, the online parent account that allows families to pay fees or apply for a waiver, register for transportation and noon supervision, as well as view student progress.

Families will need to set-up new accounts to continue to do online transactions. To create a new account families will need to have their child's CBE Student ID Number. Watch the CBE website in August for more information about the transition: www.cbe.ab.ca.

Yellow School Bus Transportation

The yellow school bus pre-registration deadline closed on June 11, 2018. Routes for the 2018-19 school year are created over the summer based on the addresses submitted before the cut off date. While CBE Transportation continues to accept registrations, these registrations will not be considered until route changes are done after Thanksgiving. Yellow school bus route maps will be posted by August 13 for modified calendar schools and August 29 for traditional calendar schools on the CBE website:

www.cbe.ab.ca/busstop.

In October, a confirmation email will be sent to all parents/guardians who have submitted a pre-registration. It will include transportation fee information and payment options (if applicable). Families can cancel their pre-registration with no financial penalty by responding to the email by October 31, 2018.
