On **Tuesday, Sept. 4**, we welcome our students to the 2018-19 school year at Ernest Manning High School. In this handout, you will find the answers to many of your back to school questions.

First Day of Classes

Timetables, ID cards, and parking passes will be issued on the following days:

- Grade 10 August 31, 9:00am – 12:00noon
- Grade 11 August 30, 12:00noon – 2:00pm
- Grade 12 August 30, 9:00am – 11:00am

On these days, Student Services will be open to support new registrations, and the School Store will be open for purchase of calculators, gym strips, clothing, and other school needs.

Our first day of classes is September 4th and the school office is open to parents Monday to Friday, all year.

The first day of classes we will have a staggered entry as follows:

- Grade 10 9:00am – 11:00am
- Grades 11 & 12 1:00pm – 3:00pm

Changes to My CBE Account

Over the summer, changes will be made to My CBE Account, the online parent account that allows families to pay fees or apply for a waiver, register for transportation and noon supervision, as well as view student progress.

Fees & Waivers

School fees will be charged to families after the start of the school year in September and October. Online fee payment is the simplest and most convenient way to pay school fees. Parents can use their online account to pay fees or apply for a waiver at: www.cbe.ab.ca/mycbe.

There are a number of different ways you are able to pay school fees, including: online using VISA, MasterCard, VISA Debit or Interac Online; in-person at schools; or by sending in a cheque to the school or CBE.
