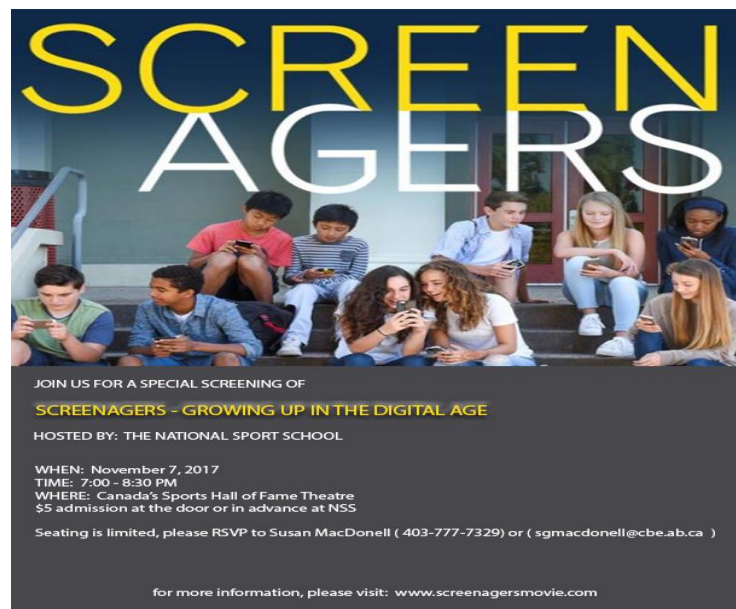
STUDENTS DRIVING HABITS
