Communiqué from WinSport: Income Tax Receipts for Fees

WinSport does not issue tax receipts for the following reasons:

- A receipt for income tax purposes is only issued by a charity or charitable organization when a 'gift' is received. The definition of a 'gift' is giving something (i.e. money) and getting nothing in return. In this case the tuition is paid and the student gets something back: unique and flexible education opportunity.
- The other aspect of a tax return that parents may be wondering about is in regards to a tax receipt that is issued by post-secondary institutions (U of C, MRU, SAIT) for tuition. NSS is not a post-secondary institution.

If a parent is looking for proof of payment, WinSport will supply receipts for credit card payments. If a parent has paid by cheque, a copy of the returned cheque from their bank can be used as proof of payment.
