**Alberta Education Requirements

The National Sport School (NSS) is a special-setting alternative “school of choice” in the Calgary Board of Education. The school is the result of a unique partnership between the CBE and WinSport. The school was created to allow potential future Olympians to continue pursuing academic excellence while training and competing in their sport specialty area. The original mandate was *“to reduce the number of high performance student-athletes were faced with the choice between sport and education ---. In our highly educated and technological society no teenager should have to make such a choice.”*

The school mission statement is:

“At the National Sport School, we provide a supportive learning environment to enable developing high-performance athletes to mature as self-directed, life-long learners while pursuing excellence in sport”.

At NSS we believe that **learning** should be:

- Personalized where curriculum more closely reflects life outside school
- Relevant with connections to student-athletes' lives
- Cross-curricular to more closely reflect our world
- Flexible to accommodate the unique learning needs of students
- Multi-dimensional to involve more than skills and content

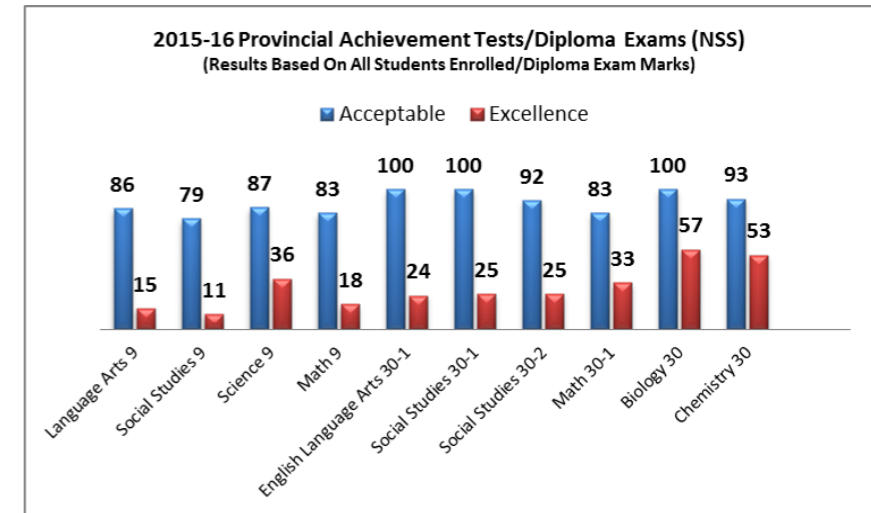
