Principal's Student Advisory Council for 2017-18

The Principal's Student Advisory Council will begin to meet with Mr. Simpson in October 2017.

What is the council for?

The purpose of the Council is to advise, consult, inform, and work with the Principal. The Council will also take an active role in leading some school-wide improvement and school community, citizenship initiatives.

What will the council do?

Over the course of the year, the Council will: meet with Mr. Simpson and discuss current issues affecting students, issues that affect our school and school community; engage in conversation about our school's future, high school redesign, student success; take an active role in leading some school-wide improvement and school community, citizenship initiatives; and support Grade 9 Transition from our feeder schools.

Who gets to be on the council?

The council should be representative of our student population, skills, interests and talents. Each grade 10, 11 and 12 will be represented on the Council. The total number of council members is dependent on interest expressed by students. Depending on the number of applicants it may be necessary to screen applications. Council members will be a combination of students nominated by teachers and selected through an application process.

Why should I consider applying?

Being on council will allow individuals to not only develop their own voice, but also develop important skills in listening to others, considering alternate viewpoints, collaborating and working with others for a shared purpose. Opportunities like this look good on resumes, and job applications. Perhaps you are really interested in providing a student voice into your school, or potentially have impact on the future directions our school might take. Maybe you want to challenge yourself by getting involved with a leadership group, and would like to take advantage of this opportunity to help realize a personal goal. Consider applying!

When will the council meet?

The council meets one time per month unless it is necessary to meet more often. Meetings will be schedule in advance on a Friday, from 11:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. As meetings are held during the school day, students must commit to make up for any work missed as a result of attending a meeting.
