

## International Baccalaureate: Diploma (Full) / Course (Partial)

AND

### Music/Band at Sir Winston Churchill High School

GRADE 10 students interested in Band MUST first enroll in:

**Music 10** Brass/Percussion (Semester One, Period One) **OR**

**Music 10** Woodwind (Semester One, Period Two)

**THEN** they are permitted to enroll in **MUSIC 15** Concert Band.

(Monday + Wednesday 7:00am-8:15am Full Year)

GRADE 11 students who are accepted into IB courses may have course conflicts with Music 20 Brass/Percussion /Woodwind classes (Periods One and Two in Semester Two.)

In the case of IB course conflicts only, students may apply for admission to Music 25 Band.

#### Grade 11 Music Class Exemption Application Process:

1. Student shows Grade 11 course registration to the music teachers by the end of May of their Grade 10 year.
2. Student placed on an IB Music Class Exemption Waiting List. Provide email contact information.  
Admission into **Music 25** Band will be based on:
  - Sufficient musical ability
  - Commitment to rehearsals and performances (TEAM)
  - Available space for your instrument in the Band (priority is given to students who take the Music 20 Brass/Percussion/ Woodwind classes)
3. Student will be contacted by email by the music teachers prior to the end of June of their Grade 10 year, as to their application status.

Grade 12 students. See above. The same Waiting List procedure applies if you still have course conflicts. In Grade 12, course names become Music 30 and Band 30. If your IB course conflicts prevented you from taking Music 20 in Grade 11, but are now resolved in Grade 12, you may enroll in **Music 20** Brass/Woodwind and **Music 35** Band.
