## FEE EXPLANATION

### INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS FEE

#### Instructional Supplies and Materials Fee

The Instructional Supplies and Materials Fee cover the basic cost of instructional supplies and materials for all courses.

#### Refundable Security Deposit

The Security Deposit guarantees the cost of lost and damaged instructional supplies and materials. If books and other instructional resources loaned to students for use in the school year are returned in satisfactory condition, the Security Deposit will be refunded. This amount is included in the mandatory fees and must be paid in September. Students or parents must claim refunds at the end of each school year. Refunds not claimed by Oct 31, 2012 will be forfeited.

### OPTIONAL ITEMS AND EVENTS/OFF-SITE ACTIVITIES

#### Yearbook

The yearbook is an optional purchase. The number of students who pay for yearbooks determines the quantity of books ordered. Orders are placed in the fall, so if students wish to obtain a yearbook payment is required with school fees. **This is the only opportunity students will have to purchase yearbooks this school year.**

#### Graduation Fees Grade 12 students only

This fee covers the cost of the graduation exercises ceremony. It includes hall rental, programs, flowers, class photo, diploma folder and graduation gown rental.

#### Fitness Centre Membership

This allows students to access the equipment in the school fitness centre. The fee covers the cost of the membership tag, the repair of existing equipment and the purchase of new equipment.

#### Art 30/31 IB

This fee covers the cost of color copying and photography for art portfolio to be submitted to IB examiners.

#### Sports Medicine 10, 20 and 30

There is no fee for Sports Medicine 10. The Sports Medicine 20 fee covers the cost of Standard First Aide, CPR-C and AED certification. The Sports Medicine 30 fee covers the cost of CPR Certification at the Health Care Level.

#### Physical Education 10

Students registered in Physical Education 10 will be assessed additional fees determined by student choice of off-campus activities.

#### Physical Education 20

Curling, golf and hiking are now curriculum requirements and cost approx. \$55.00. You will be assessed additional fees determined by the off-site activities students choose. These fees will be collected by the Phys. Ed. Department with consent forms.

#### Physical Education 30

This fee covers the cost of off-campus activities such as [Backpacking trip to Kananaskis](#), [Golf](#), [Scuba](#), [Racquetball](#), [Squash](#), [Yoga](#), [Spin cycle class](#), [Wall Climb](#), [Sailing/kayaking](#), [Bowling](#), and [Billiards](#).

#### Sports Performance 15/25/35

This fee **includes** cost of visitation and instruction for offsite activity. It no longer covers a school fitness membership pass.

#### Athletic Team Fees

The cost of participating on one of our athletic teams varies from \$45 to over \$200. Each coach submits a budget that includes tournaments, exhibition games, required equipment, travel and accommodation and training supplies. From this budget, a cost per person will be set. ***Athletic fees must be paid when the activity occurs!***

#### International Baccalaureate Registration and Exams

The Calgary Board of Education pays IB for Basic Fees and Per Capita Fees. Each IB student is responsible for Examination Fees. Exam fees are made up of an annual registration fee, subject fees and mail fee.

### LATE REGISTRATIONS, WITHDRAWALS, TRANSFERS AND REFUNDS

Students who register late will pay the full amount of the Instructional Supplies and Materials Fee and the Refundable Security Deposit for the semester.

If a student transfers to another school in the Calgary Board of Education system, a portion of the fees will be transferred to the new school. If a student is leaving the system, refunds may be issued depending on the circumstances and the date of withdrawal. For more information about refunds, please contact the Business Office.
